1. Test Site : RM 1, 2ndFLOOR, UBD – UTH

- TOPIK I : Room 1

- TOPIK II : Room 1

* The test applicants are advised to visit the test site and confirm the location before the actual day of the test.

2. Test Date: 19 MARCH, 2017 (SUNDAY)

3. Test Room Open

- TOPIK I Listening & Reading 08:40

- TOPIK II Listening & Writing 11:50

*** The test applicants are advised to arrive before the test room opens.**

4. Test Time

- TOPIK I Listening & Reading 09:10-10:50

- TOPIK II Listening & Writing 12:20-14:10

Reading: 14:40-15:50

5. Should bring:

- Identification Slip

- Identity Card (or passport)

- A pen or a pencil

- A correction tape or an eraser

6. “Computer Readable Marking Pen” will be provided to the applicants for the both Multiple-choice questions and short-answer questions during the test.

7. Mobile/Smart phones are not allowed into the venue during examinations otherwise Mobile/Smart phones must be switched off and handed to the supervisors and will be returned back after examination is over.

How to fill in the Answer Sheet

- Multiple-choice Answers (TOPIK I, TOPIK II)
 - Answers must be marked with a “Computer readable marking pen”.
 - They must NOT be marked with a pencil or a pen, in which case the answers will be deemed invalid.
 - Mistakes can be corrected using correction tape.
- Short-answer questions & essay writings of the 1st section (TOPIK II)
 - Answers must be written with a provided pen.
 - You may correct mistakes by drawing two lines over the wrong answer or by using correction tape.
- Answers with two or more answers marked will be deemed invalid.
- Information such as applicant number or applicant name should be filled in carefully so that none are missing.
- OMR answer sheets can be replaced at the applicants demand, but must be submitted promptly at the end of the test.
- Know and correctly use the below OMR marking methodology.

Policies on Cheating

- At the end of the exam all pens must be set on the desk. Answer sheet must be set on the right of the desk and test booklet on the left. It will be considered cheating to write after the end of the exam
- Cheaters will be banned from the exam room and his/her test will be nullified

Types of Cheating

1. Looking at other test applicants' answers or showing one's answer to others.
2. Referring to prepared memos or test-related books during the test.
3. Possessing or using cell phones, MP3 Players, radios or any other electronic device.
4. Forging ID or paperwork such as the exam ticket to take the test.
5. Taking the test on behalf of another person, or having another person take the test for oneself.
6. Taking notes or recording sound about the exam problems or passing on test material to other people.
7. Conducting actions that disturb the test or not complying to legitimate orders of the supervisor.
8. Other violations(including violations that are discovered after the test)
